



1 MONTH NOTICE TO END TENANCY FROM TENANT TO LANDLORD FOR A MONTHLY TENANCY

Note: Does not apply to yearly or weekly tenancies

LANDLORD'S NAME (name as shown on the tenancy agreement) (Note: this can be landlord's agent).

SERVICE ADDRESS (this is also the address where this document will be either given personally or left and mailed for service) Note: If mailed (registered or regular mail), the notice is considered served 5 days after mailing.

TENANT'S NAME(S) (name(s) as shown on the tenancy agreement).

Rental Unit Address

DATE TENANCY ENDS (the tenant must be completely moved out no later than 1pm on this date).

SIGNATURE of TENANT

The notice must be served no later than the day **before** rent is due under the tenancy agreement to start the one month clock. [Example: If rent is due July 1, the one month notice would have to be served on or before June 30 and the month of July would represent the 1 month notice period meaning the tenancy would end on July 31].

INFORMATION FOR LANDLORDS WHO RECEIVE THIS NOTICE TO END TENANCY

Unless there is a dispute about the security deposit (in which case a landlord should file an application with the Residential Tenancies Office) you are entitled to receive your security deposit within 15 days after the tenancy ends and you have provided a forwarding address to your landlord.

INFORMATION FOR LANDLORDS WHO WANT TO END A TENANCY

You have the right to dispute this Notice by filing an Application for Dispute Resolution at the Residential Tenancies Office. (Note: only valid reasons under the Residential Landlord and Tenant Act (RLTA) will be considered).

INFORMATION FOR BOTH LANDLORDS AND TENANTS

- Keep copies of all Notices to End Tenancy and record each date and how the Notice was given or received.
- An error in this Notice or an incorrect move-out date on this Notice does not necessarily make it invalid. If the move-out date does not comply with the *RLTA*, the effective date is the earliest date that complies with the *RLTA*.
