## COACH SALARY SUBSIDY

- Can support salaries for full-time or part-time higher level coaches who are coaching athletes as well as mentoring and developing other coaches, delivering clinics, etc.
- Salary assistance will be provided at a rate of \$2, up to a maximum of \$20,000 for every \$1 provided by the sport
- Must be resident of Yukon
- The ultimate desire is to support full-time professional coaches. However, consideration will be given to the support of part-time coaches who are striving to become full-time coaches.
- A copy of the employment contract or agreement must be provided
- The YSGB/Association is responsible to ensure suitability of the coach for employment. E.g. screening, reference checks.
- The coach must be willing to provide an annual Year End Summary Report in the format provided.
