

**Who should use this form?**

Anyone who would like further information on locations of species displayed by the layer entitled “CDC Species of Conservation Concern” must fill out this form. Data can be requested by noting the Element Occurrence ID. For other, custom data requests, such as all known locations of a particular species, or for spatial data, please complete the [Yukon CDC Data Release Agreement](#) and submit to the Yukon Conservation Data Centre.

**What type of information can I receive?**

The Yukon Conservation Data Centre can generate an Element Occurrence report for the Element Occurrence ID provided. This report includes species name, common name, conservation status ranks, location description, first and last observation dates and a summary of the observations made at the site. Note however that some older, historical occurrences may contain very few details.

**Why do I need to fill in this form?**

The Yukon Conservation Data Centre serves as a clearinghouse for data on species of conservation concern. While we want to make every attempt to make this data publicly available, we must also ensure that releasing the data does not harm the species in question. We therefore require some information from the data requestor so that we can better assess what the data will be used for.
