TERMS AND CONDITIONS

DEFINITIONS:

DLC – Design Light Consortium

ESC – Energy Solutions Centre

Fixture or luminaire – a complete electric light unit

Lamp – a replaceable component that produces light from electricity

ELIGIBILITY: Owners or lease holders of commercial or institutional buildings in Yukon. Commercial buildings are buildings in which the primary activity conducted within the building is business or commerce. Institutional buildings are buildings that are community-owned and operated for public purposes, such as municipal or First Nation government buildings or recreation centres. Yukon and federal government buildings are not eligible. Limit of one LED lighting or MUB thermal enclosure upgrade per business per building per year.

ELIGIBLE PRODUCTS: ENERGY STAR® or Design Light Consortium-qualified LED lamps and/or fixtures (visit www.energystar.gov or www.designlights.org to determine product qualification). Occupancy sensors must be commercial-grade. **Materials must be purchased within one year of submission date.**

Dark-Sky approved is defined as lamps / fixtures that are fully shielded, have a nominal correlated colour temperature (CCT) of 2,700K or warmer, and do not exceed a manufacturer-stated nominal CCT of 3,000K. Fully shielded is defined as a luminaire constructed and installed in such a manner that all light emitted by the luminaire, either directly from the lamp or a diffusing element, or indirectly by reflection or refraction from any part of the luminaire, is projected below the horizontal plane through the luminaire's lowest light-emitting part.

APPLICATION: LED Lighting Upgrade applicants must complete and submit this form with an LED lighting upgrade summary and copies of receipts/invoices itemizing LED lamps, fixtures and/or occupancy sensors installed.

RECEIPTS AND INVOICES: Receipts and invoices must be legible, itemized and include: purchase date, purchaser name, retailer/supplier name, brands and model numbers of items purchased (where applicable), description, and cost of components. Incentive will be calculated based on pre-tax cost of materials. **Invoices/receipt must have a zero balance or be noted “Paid in full” and initialed by the contractor.** Payment will be made to the business identified on the invoices supplied.

LIMITS TO PROGRAM: The Good Energy program is renewed annually pending fiscal year budget allocation. Rebate offers are subject to program funding and may change or end at any time. In no event will a rebate amount exceed the product, project or service value.

SUBMISSION AND PAYMENT: Government of Yukon is not responsible for lost, late, incomplete or ineligible submissions. Please allow up to twelve weeks for payment of incentive.
