## PART II: APPROVAL

A special NON-TAC Configuration Permit is hereby issued to \_\_\_\_\_ ("Permit Holder") under Yukon Highways Regulations ss 23(3), O.I.C. 2002/174 (the "Regulations"), authorizing the operation of the vehicle(s) listed in schedule "A" of this Permit subject to the following Terms and Conditions:

### TERMS AND CONDITIONS

#### 1. Applicability of permit

- a) This permit applies only to the vehicle(s) listed in schedule "A" of this permit.
- b) The permit holder owns the vehicle(s) listed in schedule "A" of this permit.

#### 2. Maximum permit length

- An escort vehicle will not be required for overall length of the vehicle combination described in schedule A, up to a length of 27.5 meters.
- A rear escort vehicle will be required when the overall length exceeds 27.5 meters.

#### 3. Vehicle/vehicles inspection/safety, insurance and registration requirements

The permit holder shall at all times:

- a) Maintain a valid periodic motor vehicle inspection (PMVI) decal for the vehicle(s) listed in schedule "A" and display a PMVI decal on each vehicle.
- b) Maintain valid registration for the vehicle(s) operated under this permit.
- c) Maintain insurance coverage for the vehicle(s) that meets or exceeds the minimum established under the Yukon *Motor Vehicles Act*.

#### 4. Suspension of the permit

The permit will be suspended, and the permit holder notified in writing of the suspension, when it is demonstrated that the permit holder is in non-compliance with:

Requirements relating to vehicle inspection/safety, or insurance or registration as set out in this permit.

#### 5. Reinstatement of permit

The permit may be reinstated once the permit holder can demonstrate that the: vehicle inspection/safety, insurance and registration requirements in section 3 of this permit have been met.

#### 6. Offence to operate at lengths in excess of the maximum overall length established by this permit.

- a) It is an offence to operate a vehicle(s) combination under this permit with a length that exceeds the maximum overall length authorized by this permit without the required escort vehicle(s).
- b) A fine may be assessed under the Summary Conviction Regulations for this offence.

#### 7. Cancellation of the permit

The minister may cancel this permit for repeated suspensions of the permit for non-compliance with permit conditions.

**8. Sale of a vehicle(s) or permanent removal from the road**

- a) When the vehicle(s) is sold or permanently removed from the road, the permit holder shall immediately notify the manager, Carrier Compliance, Transport Services Branch in writing.
- b) The permit is not transferable.

**9. Expiry of the permit**

Unless suspended or cancelled, this permit is valid for the life of the vehicle(s) listed in schedule "A".

### Drawing of vehicle or vehicle combination

Provide a sketch of the vehicle or vehicle combination in the space provided below. You may also include a photograph of the vehicle or vehicle combination, but a sketch is mandatory.

### Lift axles

Indicate which axles are lift axles by placing an "X" below the axle.

### Single tire axles

Identify single tire axle by marking it with an "S". Provide the tire size for all single tire axles.

### Front steering axle

Provide the manufacturer's axle rating for the steering axle and attach verification of that rating.

### Inter axle spacings

Provide the measurement from the center of axle to center of the next axle or axle group in metric.
