COMMISSIONER'S ORDER 1978/161

ANIMAL PROTECTION ORDINANCE

Pursuant to the provisions of the Animal Protection Ordinance, the Commissioner of the Yukon Territory is pleased to and doth hereby appoint:

1. JUDY RILEY & TOM WALTON of Whitehorse  
representing the Yukon Humane Society.  
PAULINE LUND & BEVERLY FINK of Faro Yukon  
representing the Faro Humane Society  
as special constables to have and perform the powers,  
duties and obligations defined and imposed by the said  
Ordinance: effective August 1st, 1978, throughout  
the Yukon Territory.
2. PAUL DOUGLAS LABRASH  
as special constable to have and perform the powers,  
duties and obligations defined and imposed by the  
said Ordinance: only in instances where a peace  
officer or special constable appointed in paragraph 1  
above is unable to act in their appointed position by  
reason of absence or inability.
3. Those persons employed from time to time by the  
Government of Yukon as Conservation Officers, as  
special constables to have and perform the powers,  
duties and obligations defined and imposed by the  
said Ordinance: only in instances where a peace  
officer or special constable appointed in paragraph 1  
above is unable to act in their appointed position  
by reason of absence or inability.
