COMMISSIONER'S ORDER 1974/89

Yukon Health Care Insurance Plan Ordinance


Pursuant to the provisions of the Yukon Health Care Insurance Plan Ordinance, the Commissioner of the Yukon Territory is pleased to and doth hereby order as follows:

Subsection 26(2) of the Yukon Health Care Insurance Plan Regulations is repealed and the following substituted therefor:

- "(2) In any prosecution of a person for failing to comply with the requirements of the Ordinance or Regulations relating to the payment of premiums, a certificate purporting to be signed by the Administrator alleging that:
- (a) such person has failed to remit premiums pursuant to the Ordinance and Regulations;
  - (b) such person has not been subject to premium deductions by an employer;
  - (c) such person has not otherwise remitted to the Plan the required premiums, or
  - (d) the amount of the premiums due by such person

shall be received in evidence as prima facie proof of the facts alleged therein."
