ORDER-IN-COUNCIL 1981/ 265

HOSPITAL INSURANCE SERVICES ORDINANCE

Pursuant to the provisions of the Hospital Insurance Services Ordinance, the Commissioner in the Executive Council is pleased to and doth hereby order as follows:

1. That the Regulations Respecting Hospital Insurance Services be amended by revoking Section 4 (1), 4 (2) and 4 (3) and substituting the following therefor:

4 (1) Subject to the Ordinance and these regulations, an insured person is eligible for and entitled to insured services after midnight on the last day of the second month following the month of arrival to the Territory.

4 (2) Notwithstanding subsection (1), a person who ceased to be a resident and who returns to re-establish residence shall become an insured person after midnight on the last day of the second month following the month of arrival to the Territory.

4 (3) Notwithstanding subsection (1), a landed immigrant within the meaning of the Immigration Act (Canada) shall be entitled to all the benefits of the Plan immediately upon establishing residence if he does so on or before midnight on the last day of the second month following the month of arrival to the Territory.
